REQUESTED ACTIONS:

1. Receive and file year to date fiscal update

BACKGROUND:

As part of the Conservancy's regular financial updates to the Board, staff provides a fund-level financial report (Attachment A). This report includes year to date (October 2022) revenues and expenditures. Of note:

- Revenues and expenditures in the Mitigation Fee Fund are under budget year-to-date. Current Mitigation Fee Fund permit revenues are approximately \$151,000 with expenditures of \$178,884. Approximately \$101,389 in Mitigation Fee Fund expenditures is due to the final processing of repayment of the loan from the County. Staff still anticipates fee revenue meeting or exceeding the budgeted amount of \$1,500,000.
- Grant revenues year to date are \$19,062. The current balances of the 2021 California Department of Fish and Wildlife Local Assistance Grants for the Cache Creek reserve unit and mapping activities is \$60,379 and \$18,107, respectively.

2. Approve the Millsap Site as a candidate Yolo HCP/NCCP conservation easement site

BACKGROUND:

The approximately 15-acre Millsap Site being considered for an HCP/NCCP conservation easement is held in fee title by Yolo County and located within the Cache Creek Ecological Corridor (Planning Unit 7), a Priority 1 HCP/NCCP acquisition area. Conservancy and Yolo HCP/NCCP Science and Technical Advisory Committee (STAC) representatives conducted a site visit on the Millsap Site, on August 25, 2022, and concluded that the site contains grassland and riparian habitats as well as opportunities for VELB mitigation and habitat restoration at-large. The STAC recommends enrollment of the property in the HCP/NCCP reserve system to extend the corridor of protected lands along Cache Creek as summarized in the transmittal memo (Attachment A).

The Executive Director recommends that the Board approve the Millsap Site as a candidate Yolo HCP/NCCP conservation easement site. Following Board approval staff will seek concurrence from CDFW and USFWS that the site be considered a candidate Yolo HCP/NCCP conservation easement site and, if approved, will work with Yolo County, CDFW, and USFWS staff to prepare the appropriate conservation easement documents and return to the Board for final action.



The STAC has made the following recommendation:

The STAC recommends the board approve the Millsap Site as a candidate Yolo HCP/NCCP reserve system site. The approximately 15-acre property being considered for enrollment in the Yolo HCP/NCCP reserve system is located on an upper bench along the north bank of Cache Creek. While the site does not include the main creek channel, it does contain riparian vegetation that is part of the adjoining riparian corridor and is within a priority acquisition area. The site is immediately adjacent to other lands actively being considered for enrollment in the Yolo HCP/NCCP reserve system. Enrollment of the Millsap site in the reserve system would provide an additional protected linkage to the wildlife corridor along Cache Creek.

The site provides suitable habitat for Swainson's hawk, white-tailed kite, western pond turtle, and valley elderberry longhorn beetle (VELB). Swainson's hawks occur commonly along the Cache Creek corridor and throughout the adjacent farmlands. Although not supporting foraging habitat, the site does provide nesting habitat and has the potential to provide additional nesting habitat, presumably as upper terrace valley oak woodland, for both Swainson's hawk and white-tailed kite with restoration. Multiple western pond turtles have been documented along the Cache Creek channel within 1,000 feet of the property. While the site does not provide aquatic habitat, it does support easily accessible high value nesting habitat for western pond turtle. The property also supports at least 10 mature elderberry shrubs which are large enough to provide habitat for VELB. Restoration efforts could expand habitat for VELB by increasing elderberry shrub density.

The approximately 92-acre portion of the YCFCWCD parcels that is being considered for an HCP/NCCP conservation easement is located within the Cache Creek Ecological Corridor (Planning Unit 7), a Priority 1 HCP/NCCP acquisition area. Conservancy and Yolo HCP/NCCP Science and Technical Advisory Committee (STAC) representatives conducted a site visit on the YCFCWCD parcels, on August 25, 2022, and concluded that the site contains high value riparian and wetland habitats as well as opportunities for VELB mitigation and habitat restoration at-large. The STAC recommends enrollment of the property in the HCP/NCCP reserve system as summarized in the transmittal memo (Attachment A).

The Executive Director recommends that the Board approve the YCFCWCD parcels as a candidate Yolo HCP/NCCP conservation easement site. Following Board approval staff will seek concurrence from CDFW and USFWS that the site be considered a candidate Yolo HCP/NCCP conservation easement site and, if approved, will work with the landowner, CDFW, and USFWS staff to prepare the appropriate conservation easement documents and return to the Board for final action.


The STAC has made the following recommendation:

The STAC recommends the board approve the YCFCWCD parcels as a candidate Yolo HCP/NCCP reserve system site. The approximately 92 acres being considered for enrollment in the Yolo HCP/NCCP reserve system are within the Cache Creek corridor and include approximately 4,000 linear feet of the Cache Creek corridor including a mosaic of mature riparian forest, emergent wetlands, and upland grasslands on both sides of the active channel as well as gravel bars and open water within and adjacent to the active channel. The land cover types on this site provide habitat for seven Yolo HCP/NCCP covered species. The Cache Creek corridor is a high priority acquisition area and this property would contribute to the goal of protecting and managing this important resource within the Conservancy's reserve system.

The site provides suitable habitat for Swainson's hawk, white-tailed kite, western pond turtle, valley elderberry longhorn beetle (VELB), tricolored blackbird, least Bell's vireo, and western yellow-billed cuckoo. The primary value of the site for Swainson's hawk and white-tailed kite is the protection of riparian and oak woodland nesting habitat and secondarily patches of open grassland foraging habitat. The property supports high value aquatic and upland habitat for western pond turtle, which have been recently documented on the site. The protection of the site represents a significant contribution to conservation of this species along Cache Creek and the county at-large. The property supports many mature elderberry shrubs, which are habitat for VELB, in both riparian and upland portions of the site. The open grasslands provide important foraging habitat for tricolored blackbird. While no tricolored blackbird nest sites are found on the site, a nesting colony has been documented on the adjacent parcel to the east. The property supports mature cottonwood-willow riparian, essential habitat for least Bell's

vireo and western yellow-billed cuckoo along Cache Creek, the protection of which may represent the best opportunity for future occupancy by these species in the county.
